Canteen Manager

Plan, organise, and monitor the operations of the club canteen. The position will be paid a negotiated hourly rate or a percentage of the takings. Commitment is estimated as 10 hours per week, stocking and preparation and 10 hours per week managing canteen operations.

Canteen Convenor

Open and operate the canteen service for the allocated shift, keep operating records, and supervise volunteer staff. The position is paid a negotiated hourly rate and you must be available 10 hours per week rostered in maximum 5-6 hour shifts on one of Friday 5pm - 10pm, Saturday 9am-5.30pm OR Sunday 9am-5.30pm.

We also require boys and girls for regular Saturdays ages 15 -19 to help the convenors in the canteen.

30 min each Thurs putting three Size 4 and three Size 5 match balls at the correct pressure in the Referee's Room for the weekend games.


